**October 2009** --The Society is very proud to announce that the first journal impact factor (IF) has been reported for the Journal of Neuroimmune Pharmacology, our official journal. The IF is 2.456 and is an outstanding accomplishment for our journal editor, Dr. Howard Gendelman, the editorial board, and the Society, in light of the fact that the journal's first issue appeared in March of 2006, only 3 1/2 years ago. In this short time, the JNIP impact has matched or exceeded the median impact of its peer journals in Immunology, Neuroscience, Pharmacology and Infectious Diseases, most of which have been published for decades more than JNIP. For example, in the category of pharmacology and pharmacy, the median IF is 2.290.
